2/2 John Charteris's wartime letters to Noel Charteris

The letters, telegrams and postcards summarised in 2/1/1-4. There are 1255 separate communications, sometimes several a day, written almost every day that JC was not on home leave.

The original letters have been sorted into chronological order and placed in separate folders for each of the months from Aug 1914 to Sep 1918. For microfilming purposes the letters were numbered consecutively from Jan to Dec of each year. A table giving the blocks of numbers allocated to each month appears overleaf.
