The King's College mascot origins date back to the 1920s. In 1922, to rival 'Phineas', the University College London (UCL) mascot, some King's College students obtained a 5 ft tall metal beer bottle to parade during the Commemoration Week sports events with UCL. The King's female students did not approve and agreed to the suggestion of a lion mascot by Miss M R J Edwards. A lion made of beaten copper painted red was found in a brewery on Euston Road. The lion was first christened Lucy, and shortly afterward was renamed 'Reggie' and adopted as the College mascot. 'Reggie' suffered damage over the years, including during a rampage of elephants in the 1931 Lord Mayor's Parade and damage caused during various 'kidnaps' by students from other universities in London. In the 1970s 'Reggie' was filled with concrete to try to prevent any more kidnaps. In 2003 'Reggie' was restored and now is installed in 'Lion's walk' in the Macadam Building on the King's College London Strand Campus.
