I/1	The original typescript of the book.
I/2	The index North made for his book.
I/3	This section contains all the correspondence about Gallipoli. There are letters from people who fought in the campaign giving North advice and personal accounts, there are letters commenting on the book itself and on various reviews of it. All the letters are arranged alphabetically by correspondent (as North himself kept them) and chronologically within this. The correspondence is listed in detail and indexed under personal names of the correspondents.
I/4a	This section is made up of newspaper cuttings about North's book "Gallipoli", mainly reviews. The cuttings have been listed briefly and indexed under author where relevant. Most of them are identified by date and the place of publication.
I/4b	This section contains newspaper cuttings about the Gallipoli campaign itself and reviews of other Gallipoli books. The cuttings are listed briefly and are indexed under personal name and subject headings. Where possible, the date and place of publication of the cutting has been given.
I/5	This section contains the photographs which North took of Gallipoli for his book. These were also exhibited at the Imperial War Museum in 1937. The photographs have been listed.

NORTH IV - Arrangement

- IV/1 Articles written by North, mainly about World War II.  
Most of these articles were written by North himself, except a few to be found in the miscellaneous section and one by Alexander on Alam Halfa and one by Gault MacGowan on North's work. On the whole, the order of the articles has been maintained. Very few of the articles are actually dated, but, where possible, the date of the article has been given, along with the details of where it was published. In many cases, the latter is merely represented by initials and the archivist has not identified these abbreviations. Most of the articles were written about World War II and appeared to fall into three major groups: training and personnel, tactics and weaponry, actual incidents and individuals. The articles have also been indexed according to subject heading and cross references have been made where necessary.
- IV/2 Miscellaneous correspondence, mainly 1960s.  
North's own order has been adhered to as much as possible. There is no detailed list, but everything has been indexed under the personal name of the correspondents and cross references under subject heading, have been made where necessary.
- IV/3 Various press cuttings.  
Mainly press cuttings, arranged in alphabetical order. It was decided not to move too many of the papers around, but to keep as much as possible to North's own order. Because of this, some correspondence (mainly linked to the press cuttings) is included in this section. There is no detailed list, however, everything is indexed under subject and/or personal name heading and cross references have been included where necessary.
- IV/4 Correspondence 1936-1939.  
Most of the correspondence covers this period, but some (mainly in section IV/4a) is earlier. The correspondence was arranged alphabetically and this system has been retained, but it was found that the letters fell into several subject groups. For clarity and ease to the reader, they have been divided into the following sections;
- IV/4a Correspondence about North's book "A Shade Byronic".  
Mainly letters to journalists, with thanks and comments from friends. The arrangement of the letters is alphabetically by correspondent and chronologically within this. The correspondence has not been listed in detail.
- IV/4b Correspondence about cars.  
North appears to have had a special interest in Chrysler motors, so these letters have been kept separate. Again the letters are arranged alphabetically and chronologically within this. They have not been listed in detail.
- IV/4c Correspondence, 1936-1939  
This section contains North's most interesting correspondence of this period. The subjects of the letters vary greatly: the imminent world war and North's views, his opinions on prominent figures of war and politics and discussions with friends on books, war and politics. The arrangement of the letters is alphabetical and chronological within this. The correspondence has been listed in detail.

Much of this correspondence is with an American, Major J.D. Roberts whom North met in Africa. This correspondence is arranged in chronological order and has been listed. The other correspondence has been arranged in alphabetical order as far as possible, although there are some official letters which are not addressed to anyone and cannot be identified. This correspondence has been listed briefly.  
All letters in North IV/4 have been indexed.
